## Memorandum of Understanding

The APEC Architect Project Monitoring Committees of Hong Kong and Chinese Taipei met on 8 December 2006 at the premises of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects on 19 floor, 1 Hysan Avenue, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong. The meeting was held for the purposes of increasing understanding of each other's cultural, social and economic backgrounds, exchange of ideas as well as searching for a common ground for their architects to have opportunities to practice architecture under the two economic entities.

It has been mutually agreed by the two Monitoring Committees that they will explore the possibility of establishing a mechanism to eventually allow barrier-free provision of architectural services between the signatories of this Memorandum.
